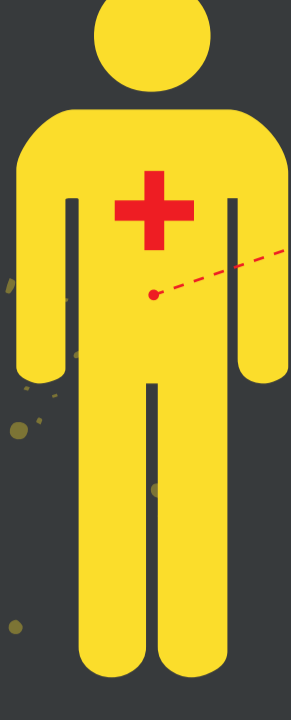

Fly facts

The fly kills more people in **four** minutes than sharks do in a year



Flies carry salmonella which is the pathogen that causes the most hospital admissions in the UK - about **2,500** each year



Flies are the most dangerous animals on earth and are responsible for more human deaths than any other creature

A study by Dr. Yao and Dr. Yuan of China found that flies carry no less than **1,941,000** bacteria on their bodies



That's **60,000%** more bacteria than a toilet seat

- Flies don't grow, they are born full size
- True flies are the only insects with two wings; all others have four
- Flies reaction times are 12 times faster than the average human



There are more than **120,000** species of flies worldwide

It is projected that if a pair began producing eggs in April, and all flies survived, theoretically they could produce **191, 010, 000, 000, 000, 000** (191 quintillion, 10 quadrillion) offspring by August...



And within a year they would cover the earth in a layer 8 feet deep!

START OUTSIDE...



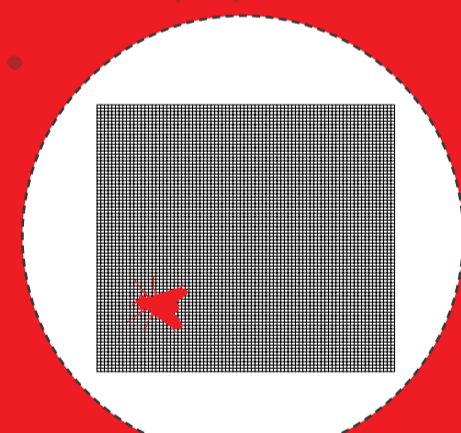
Your bin area should be as far away from your kitchen as possible, with all bins having well fitting lids that are kept closed.

TIP: A bin store will stop animals or the wind from blowing your bins over.



When the bin is emptied, the bin area and bins should be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. Sweeping, followed by hosing down with a pressure washer, can help make this a quick job.

TIP: Use a strong cleaner and sanitiser to take the effort out of cleaning your bin area



A fly screen offers your first physical line of defence against flies. Metal fly screens are best for commercial kitchens as they can withstand constant use.



TIP: Regular use of drain unblocker will keep drains flowing freely so that they don't attract flies.



Drains outside your kitchen can also attract flies; it's good practice to clean these whilst cleaning your bin.

THEN INSIDE



Food attracts flies, so keep it covered. Lids should be used for all containers, even during service.

Foot pedal bins are perfect for commercial kitchens. By putting food waste in a closed top bin means it won't attract flies.



Clean and sanitise bins between uses and tie all used bin bags before taking them straight to your outdoor bin area.

Where you position your fly killer can make all the difference. If the fly killer is visible from outside your kitchen then it will be counterproductive as it draws flies inside. The square metre coverage advertised on a machine assumes that it is located centrally in the room; if you place your fly killer against the wall you should half the advertised coverage.



Above entrance doors is usually a good place for a fly killer as it will catch flies entering the kitchen and is not visible from the outside

- If you are unsure of the age of your bulbs, or if they are still emitting the correct light, there are some simple tests you can carry out with everyday objects
- Only U.V light will activate reactive lenses
- The quinine in tonic water will glow if U.V light is present
- A white pigment free object will glow
